



High-Quality Education in Pacifica

Pacifica School District (PSD) provides students in our community with a great education. We are committed to supporting student success and preparing local children for bright futures.

Repairs and Upgrades Are Needed in Elementary and Middle Schools

State funding for school improvements is limited, and it has been over 20 years since our district's last education facility bond measure. Old buildings need to be repaired or replaced, and outdated heating systems require updates. Although our schools have received modernizations in the last 20 years, our facilities require significant upgrades to ensure the continued health and safety of every student in Pacifica.

In today's 21st-century world, updated classrooms and technology improvements are essential to building a strong academic foundation and preparing our students for high school, college and the competitive job market of tomorrow.

Local Funding to Upgrade Pacifica Schools

In order to maintain safe schools and promote a high-quality education, the Pacifica School District Board of Trustees is considering placing a \$55 million local education bond measure on the June 2018 ballot. A potential measure would:

- Improve classrooms, labs and computer systems to support programs in science, technology, English, arts and math
- Fix aging and leaking roofs
- Repair or replace outdated electrical and heating systems
- Update classrooms, kitchen facilities and restrooms to stay current with health and safety codes
- Build additional classrooms and replace portables as needed

Fiscal Accountability Provisions



- A potential measure would cost property owners no more than \$30 per \$100,000 of assessed value (not market value) per year
- All funds would go to Pacifica School District, be controlled locally and could not be taken away by the State
- An independent citizens' oversight committee and reports to the community would be required to ensure funds are spent as voters intended
